**DISTRIBUTION OF START LISTS/OFFICIAL RESULTS/MEETING MINUTES**

Start Orders, Official Results, and Team Captains' Meeting Minutes will be available at Competition Headquarters. The results will be distributed at the conclusion of the event.

**COMPETITORS' START NUMBERS**

All race bibs must be returned to the designated race officials after each training and competition event. If a bib is not returned after a competition, the athlete may be disqualified from further competition. Bibs will be available at the event location (Byrd House-Satre Hill, Mohawk Lodge, Mohawk), one hour prior to the competition. After the last competition the athletes may keep their race bibs.

**WAX FACILITIES**

Waxing facilities will be provided at all venues.

**AWARDS**

A podium ceremony will be held outside the Byrd House following the conclusion of each ski jumping event and at the Mohawk Ski Lodge following each cross country race event. Medals will be awarded at the Awards Banquet Saturday night, February 27<sup>th</sup>.

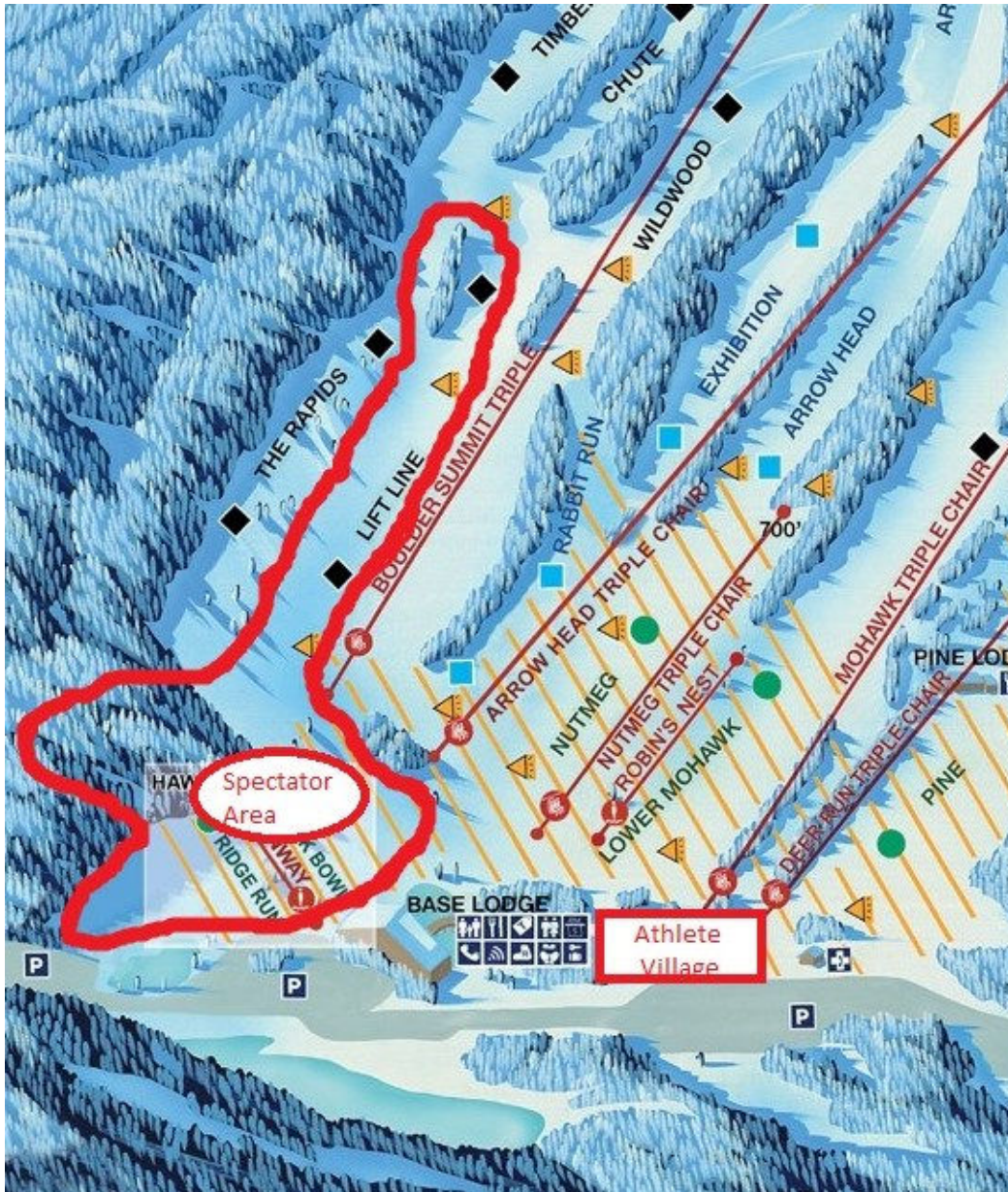
### Event Rules and Competitions

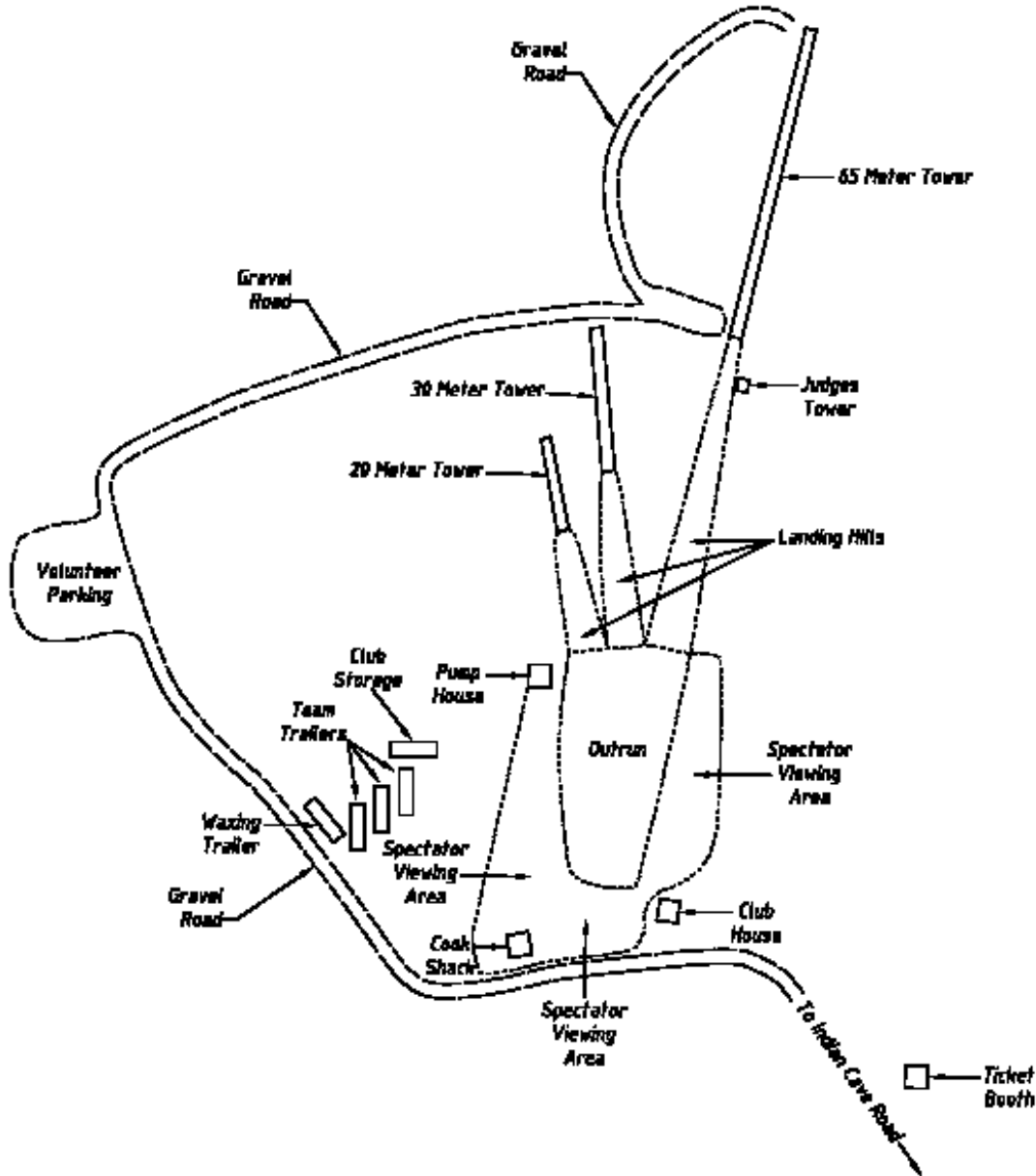
The organizing committee will assume each coach is aware of the rules and will ask for questions and comments at the first team captain's meeting.
